

Group Text



- 2. Introduce creatives with varied cultural taste to one another
- 3. Bring to life the creativity of all Detroit is Different content creators
- 4. Develop a space that is filled with a mix of the sound of Detroit culture
- 5. Develop a space that is filled with a mix of the sights of Detroit culture
- 6. Develop a space that is filled with foods that make the tastes of Detroit culture
- 7. Develop a space that is filled with a mix of scents that warm guests
- 8. Produce a dynamic multi-cultural event within a Detroit residential neighborhood which lacks sufficient artistic outlets of expression
- 9. Welcome all guests to experience a wide array of sub-cultures of Detroit guided by the content creators associated with Detroit is Different
- 10. Host a series of discussions about the role culture plays in quality of life
- 11. Host a think tank to define objectives that heighten the quality of cultural place-making, creation, facilitation, accessibility, and acceptance
- 12. Facilitate content creators bringing to life online experiences
- 13. Strengthen a foundation of creativity that can build more events and artistry
